MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - DECEMBER, 1940

The Canadian output of gold in December amounted to 450,132 ounces; in the preceding month, 450,006 ounces were produced while in December, 1939 the output was 434,546 ounces, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the calendar year 1940 Canada produced 5,302,920 ounces compared with 5,094,379 ounces a year ago.

Production in Ontario rose to 280,048 ounces made up of 126,602 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 83,187 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 70,259 ounces from other sources. In November, the Porcupine camp produced 124,008 ounces, the Kirkland Lake area, 82,848 ounces and other sources, 71,624 ounces.

An increase of 2.4 per cent was recorded in the output of gold in Quebec; the December production was 88,472 ounces and the November total, 86,369 ounces. During the **talend**ar year, Quebec produced 1,017,403 ounces or 6.7 per cent above the output a year ago.

Operators in British Columbia reported an output of 51,192 ounces; this represented an increase of 9.8 per cent above the production a year ago. Output in this province during the calendar year totalled 615,005 ounces or 1.9 per cent below the 1939 total.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 21,618 ounces in December as against 21,970 ounces a year ago.

Yukon's production of alluvial gold was recorded at 916 ounces compared with 4,176 ounces in December, 1939.

Mines in the Northwost Territories produced 6,999 ounces or 27.6 per cent above the output in November, and 41.6 per cent above the December, 1939 production.

Shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint from Nova Scotia in December amounted to 871 ounces; in the preceding month, 2,241 ounces were shipped from this province.

Jewellery and scrap receipts at the Royal Canadian Mint during 1940 contained 10,642 ounces of gold; in the preceding year, the gold content of these receipts was 12,251 ounces.
