The Cenadian production of gold in any rose to 442,521 ounces from the precedin'; montin's totel of 4i8,636 ounces and the Naj, 1939 outrut of 432, 359 ounces, accordine to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Durinc the fivo montizs ending May, Canade prodiced s,120,765 ounces compored with 2,055,6e2 ources a yeer ago and $1,826,859$ ounces in the corresponding period of 1938 .

An increase of 2.7 per cent wes recorded in tise Ontario gold production; t::e liay total was 269,888 ounces and ti:e April output 262,845 ounces. The Porcupine comp produced 117,347 ounces in liay, the Kirkland Lake area, 87,985 ounces, and other sources 64,556 ounces. During April, the Porcupine camp's output was 114,909 ounces rhile the Kirklind Lake area produced 83,097 ounces airt other areas, 64,837 oinces.

Quebec operators reported an output of 83,037 ounces or 0.9 ner ceint above the April production. During tize first five months of ti:e current yerr, 415,964 ounces were produced as ayainst 409,079 ounces a your ago.

Production from Eritish Columbia sources was 12 per cent hig'ler at 53,309 ompes. In April, 47,591 ounces mere produced wille durine the year to date, 251,068 ounces mere produced.

Manitobe and Sasketchowan nrociuced 22,27: ounces in May; in the preceding nonth, 18,821 ounces mere extracterl.

Yukon end the Nortimest Territories produced 15,175 ounces in May as ageinst 4,966 ounces in April. Production from these sources during the period Jeminrer to Mey aggregated 32,073 ounces.

The Royal Canadian ifint received 1,337 ounces of gold from Nove Scotia sources in liay compared rith 2,111 ounces in April.

In May, gold everaged 88.50 per ounce, in Canadian funds; at this price tio Canadian outpit during the moatil vas worth $\$ 17,037,058$.

Roceipts of jewellery and scrap at tine Royal Canadian Mint in i..ay contained 951 ounces of gold, thus making the gold content of these receipts for tho year to date 4,915 ounces.

The American Bureau of lietal Statistics re?orts tiat South Africa produced 1,186,000 ounces of gold in Mar compred vith 1,171,000 ounces in the preceding montil. Production in the United States totilled 471,442 ounces and consisted of ?37,140 ounces received at private smelters end refineries, 533,901 ounces received at tire livint, and 401 ounces contrined in ore and base bullion exported.
