## MONTHLY REPORT

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1941

Gold production in Canada during January totalled 434,259 ounces compared with 450,132 ounces in December and 424,381 ounces in January, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Ontario's output was recorded at 267,668 ounces made up of 120,403 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 79,987 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 67,278 ounses from other sources. In December, the Porcupine camp produced 126,602 ounces, the Kirkland Lake area, 83,187 ounces and other sources, 70,259 ounces.

Production in Quebec rose to 89,660 ounces from the December total of 88,472 ounces and the January, 1940 output of 83,505 ounces.

British Columbia produced 47,496 ounces in January as against 51,192 ounces in the preceding month and 43,891 ounces in January, 1940.

Operators in Manitoba and Saskatchewan reported an output of 21,790 ounces compared with 21,625 ounces a year ago.

Mines in the Northwest Territories produced 4,580 ounces; in the corresponding month of 1940, these mines produced 4,764 ounces.

Nova Scotia operators shipped 2,352 ounces of gold to the Royal Canadian Mint in January; during the previous month, 871 ounces were shipped while in January, 1940, shipments totalled 2,585 ounces.

Alluvial gold production from Yukon declined to 708 ounces from the total of 1,960 ounces produced a year ago.

Receipts of jewellery and scrap at the Royal Canadian Mint in January contained 948 ounces of gold; the gold content of these receipts in January, 1940 was 1,516 ounces.
