GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1941	and the second s

Gold production in Canada during October was recorded at 461,168 ounces compared with 445,085 ounces in the preceding month and 468,170 ounces in October, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the ten months ending October totalled 4,466,373 ounces or 1.3 per cent above the total for the corresponding period of 1940.

Ontario produced 269,706 ounces of gold in October, 1941, made up of 119,039 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 83,437 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 67,230 ounces from other sources. During October, 1940 Ontario's output was 279,669 ounces consisting of 122,360 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 85,056 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 72,253 ounces from other sources.

Quebec operators reported an output of 92,681 ounces or 2.5 per cent above the October, 1940 total of 90,407 ounces. During the ten months ending October 1941 Quebec produced 896,309 ounces compared with 844,030 ounces a year ago.

Production from British Columbia sources amounted to 49,581 ounces as against 49,903 ounces in the preceding month and 55,379 ounces in October, 1940.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 27,120 ounces in October; this represented an increase of 20.4 per cent over the October, 1940 total of 22,508 ounces.


Yukon produced 11,183 ounces in October; during the corresponding month of 1940, production from this source totalled 13,958 ounces.

In the Northwest Territorics production amounted to 8,770 ounces in October as against 4,591 ounces a year ago.

Shipments from Nova Scotia mines to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 2,072 ounces as against 1,628 ounces for October, 1940.
