MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - NOVEMBER, 1941

Gold production in Canada during November was recorded at 442,337 ounces compared with 461,168 ounces in October and 450,712 ounces in November, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production during the eleven months ending November totalled 4,909,210 ounces or 1.0 per cent above the total for the corresponding period of 1940.

Ontario produced 253,582 ounces of gold in November, 1941, made up of 123,010 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 63,866 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 6,706 ounces from other sources. During November, 1940 Ontario's output was 278,772 ounces, consisting of 124,008 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 82,848 ounces from the Lirkland Lake field and 71,916 ounces from other sources.

Quebec reports an output of 95,957 ounces or 1.1 per cent above the November, 1940 total of 86,519 ounces. During the eleven months ending November, 1941 Suebec produced 990, 266 ounces compared with 930, 549 ounces a year ago.

British Columbia produced 53,278 ounces compared with 49,581 ounces in the preceding month and 49,792 ounces in November, 1940.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 26,832 ounces in November; this repreposted an increase of 1.2 per cent over the November, 1940 total of 22,370 ounces.

Yukon production for November totalled 6,579 ounces as against 5,462 ounces for the corresponding month of 1940.

In the Morthwest Territories production amounted to 7,086 ounces in November, 1941 and 5,515 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 1,494 ounces and in November, 1940 the shipments totalled 2,241 ounces.
