## MONTHLY REPORT

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - DECEMBER, 1941

Gold production in Canada during December was recorded at 419,104 ounces compared with 442,837 ounces in November and 450,862 ounces in December, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Ontario produced 238,769 ounces of gold in December, 1941 made up of 122,963 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 49,758 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 66,048 ounces from other sources. During December, 1940 Ontario's output was 280,410 ounces, consisting of 126,838 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 83,025 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 70,547 ounces from other sources.

Quebec reports an output of 97,594 ounces or 1.1 per cent above the December, 1940 total of 88,626 ounces. During the twelve months of 1941, Quebec produced 1,087,860 ounces compared with 1,019,175 ounces for the twelve months of 1940.

British Columbia produced 47,898 ounces compared with 53,278 ounces in the preceding month and 51,359 ounces in December, 1940.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 25,654 ounces in December; this represented an increase of 1.2 per cent over the December, 1940 total of 21,686 ounces.

Yukon production for December totalled 890 ounces as against 855 ounces for the corresponding month of 1940.

In the Northwest Territories production amounted to 7,746 ounces in December, 1941 and 7,040 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 525 ounces and in December, 1940 the shipments totalled 871 ounces.
