MONTHLY REPORT

COLD PRODUCTION IN CAMADA - FEBRUARY, 1941

Gold production in Canada during February totalled 412,730 ounces compared with 434,759 ounces in January and 405,365 ounces in February, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Ontario's output was recorded at 256,336 ounces made up of 115,651 ounces from the Forcupine camp, 75,054 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 65,631 ounces from other sources. In January, the Porcupine camp produced 120,403 ounces, the Kirkland Lake area, 79,387 ounces and other sources, 67,278 ounces.

Production in Quebec declined to 85,355 ounces from the January total of 89,660 cunces and the February, 1940 output of 80,607 ounces.

British Columbia produced 44,306 ounces in February as against 47,496 ounces in the preceding month and 40,376 ounces in February, 1940.

Operators in Manitoba and Saskatchewan reported an output of 20,575 ounces compared with 19,422 ounces a year ago.

Mines in the Northwest Territories produced 4,982 ounces; in the corresponding month of 1940, these mines produced 4,100 ounces.

Nova Scotia operators shipped 1,176 ounces of gold to the Royal Canadian Mint in February; during the previous month, 2,352 ounces were shipped while in February, 1940 shipments totalled 1,152 ounces.

Receipts of jewellery and scrap at the Royal Canadian Mint in February contrined 704 punces of gold; the gold content of these receipts in February, 1940 was 822 ounces.
