MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CAMADA - MAY, 1941

The Canadian production of gold in May rose to 449,185 ounces from the preceding month's output of 439,556 ounces and the May, 1940 total of 443,199 ounces, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Production from Ontario sources totalled 271,174 ounces, consisting of 119,539 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 84,621 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 67,014 ounces from other sources. During May, 1940 Ontario produced 270,153 ounces.

Quebec operators reported an output of 89,884 ounces during May, as against 88,540 in the previous month and 83,182 ounces in May 1940.

British Columbia's output was recorded at 49,927 ounces or 8.7 per cent above the April total and 6.6 per cent below the May, 1940 production.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 23,692 ounces compared with 22,342 ounces, a year ago.

Operations in the Northwest Territories resulted in the production of 5,726 ounces of gold; this represented an increase of 42.7 per cent over the May, 1940 total.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint contained 2,795 ounces of gold; a year ago, the gold content of shipments from this source was 1,837 ounces.

Alluvial gold production from Yukon amounted to 5,986 ounces compared with 8,185 ounces, a year ago.

Jewellery and scrap receipts at the Royal Canadian Mint in May contained 955 ounces of gold, thus making the total gold content of these shipments during the current year, 3,970 ounces.
