## MONTHLY REPORT

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1941

The Canadian output of gold in July totalled 456,650 ounces; in the preceding month, 453,987 ounces were produced while in July, 1940 the production was 457,330 ounces, according to a recort just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first seven months of the current year, Canada produced 3,092,896 ounces or 2 per cent above the output a year ago.

Ontario's output in July amounted to 270,464 ounces and consisted of 116,672 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 90,122 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 63,670 ounces from other sources. In July, 1940 Ontario produced 279,973 ounces, made up of 122,153 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 89,331 ounces from the Kirkland Lake area and 68,489 ounces from other sources.

A 13.4 per cent increase was recorded in Quebec's production in July compared with the output for the corresponding month of 1940; the totals were 91,440 ounces and 80,646 ounces, respectively.

British Columbia produced 52,177 ounces as against 55,047 ounces in the preceding month and 58,475 ounces in July, 1940.

Operators in Manitoba and Saskatchewan reported an output of 22,908 ounces during the month under review; this represented an increase of 5.9 per cent over the total of 21,630 ounces in July, 1940.

Production in the Northwest Territories during July totalled 6,869 ounces or 51.5 per cent above the output a year ago of 4,534 ounces.

Yukon produced 11,104 ounces of alluvial gold in July compared with 9,932 ounces in the corresponding month of 1940.

Shipments from Nova Scotia mines to the Royal Canadian Mint in July contained 1,662 ounces of gold as against 2,111 ounces in July, 1940.

The gold content of jewellery and scrap receipts at the Royal Canadian Mint in July amounted to 736 ounces or 5.4 per cent above the total for the corresponding month a year ago.
