MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - AUGUST, 1941

Gold production in Canada during August was recorded at 467,224 ounces compared with 456,650 ounces in the preceding month and 466,946 ounces in August, 1940, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawe. Production during the eight months ending August totalled 3,560,120 ounces or 1.7 per cent above the total for the corresponding period of 1940.

Ontario produced 274,555 ounces of gold in Aug. 1941, made up of 122,838 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 86,869 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 64,848 ounces from other sources. During August, 1940 Ontario's output was 275,176 ounces consisting of 119,104 ounces from the Porcupine camp, 39,677 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 70,395 ounces from other sources.

Quebec operators reported an output of 91,936 ounces or 7.5 per cent above the August, 1940 total of 35,528 ounces. During the eight months ending August, 1941 Quebec produced 715,482 cunces compared with 664,374 ounces a year ago.

Production from British Columbia sources amounted to 58,401 ounces as against 52,177 ounces in the preceding month and 58,485 ounces in August, 1940.

Manitoba and Sasketchewan produced 24,87% ounces in August; this represented an increase of 11.5 per cent over the August, 1940 total of 22,313 ounces.

Yukon produced 10,485 ounces in August; during the corresponding month of 1940, production from this source totalled 15,070 ounces.

In the Northwest Territories production amounted to 5,484 ounces in August as against 4,564 ounces a year ago.

Shipments from Nova Scotia mines to the Royal Canadian Mint declined to 1,543 ounces in August from the August, 1940 total of 1,791 ounces.
