MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JANUARY, 1942

Gold production in Canada during January, 1942 was recorded at 405,664 ounces compared with 421,316 ounces in December, 1941 and 434,259 ounces in January, 1941, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Ontario produced 223,912 ounces of gold in January, 1942 made up of 118,282 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 47,293 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 58,337 ounces from other sources. During Jamuery, 1941 Onterio's output was 267,668 bunces, consisting of 120,403 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 79,987 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 67,278 ounces from other sources.

Jamuary, 1941 total of 89,660 ounces, and 1.0 per cent above the December, 1941 total of 97,594.

British Columbia produced 46,375 cunces compared with 47,898 ounces in December and 47,496 owices in January, 1941.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 24,976 cunces in January; this represented an increase of 1.2 per cent over the January, 1941 total of 21,790 ounces.

Yukon production for January totalled 15 ounces as against 708 for the corresponding month of 1941.

In the Northwest Territories production amounted to 8,023 ounces in January, 1942 and 4,580 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Mova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 2,538 ounces and in Jamuary, 1941 the shipments totalled 2,352 ounces.
