MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - NOVEMBER, 1942

According to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, the gold production for November, 1942 was recorded at 362,652 fine ounces. For October, 1942 the report read 381,845 fine ounces and for November, 1941, 442,837 fine ounces.

In Onterio the gold production for November, 1942 totalled 208,685 ounces, made up of 99,320 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 58,480 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field, and 50,885 ounces from other sources. For November, 1941 the output was 255,582 ounces, made up of 123,010 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 63,866 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field, and 66,706 ounces from other sources.

Quebec production during November, 1942 was 82,069 ounces as against 91,643 ounces for October, 1942 and 93,957 ounces for November, 1941.

British Columbia produced 28,727 ounces in November compared with 23,361 ounces for October, 1942 and 53,278 ounces for Wovember, 1941.

Manitobs produced 20,885 ounces in November, 1942 compared with 25,110 ounces for November, 1941.

Production for the Yukon amounted to 6,800 ounces for November as against an output of 6,579 ounces for November, 1941.

In the Northwest Territories, production amounted to 7,675 ounces for November, 1942 and 7,086 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 811 ounces and for November, 1941 the shipments totalled 1,494 ounces.
