## MONTHLY REPORT

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CAIVADA - DECEMBER, 1342

According to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, the gold production for December, 1942 was reaorded at 359,903 fine ounces for November, 1942. the report read 362,652 fine ounces and for December, 1941421,316 fine ounces.

In Ontario the gold production for December, 1942 totalled 213.116 ounces, made up of 95,329 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 67,647 ounces from the Kirkiand Lake field, and 50,140 ounces from other sources. For December, 1941 the output was 238,769 ounces, made up of 122,963 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 49,758 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field, and $6 \epsilon, 048$ ounces from other sources.

Quebec production during December, 1942 was 84,107 ounces as against 89,069 ourcos for November, 1942 and 97,594 ounces for December, 1941.

British Columbia produced 25,998 ounces in December compared with 28,727 ounces for November, 1942 and 47,898 ounces for December, 1941.

Manitoba produced 26,715 ounces in December, 1942 compare 3 with 24,233 ounces for December, 1941.

Production for the Yukon amounted to 2,442 ounces for December as against an output of 890 ounces for December, 1941.

In the Northwest Territories, production amounted to 6:705 Minces for December, 1942 and 9,958 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 820 ounces and for December, 1941 the shipments totalled 525 ounces.
