## MONTHLY REPORT

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JUNS, 1942

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa records the June, 1942 gold production at 425,067 fine ounces. This is only a few ounces less than the output for May, but 6.4 per cent less than the June output last year.

Ontario gold production during June, 1942 totalled 237,980 ounces, made up of 114,778 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 66,808 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field, and 56,394 ounces from other sources. During June, 1941 the output was 268, 100 ounces, made up of 116,691 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 85,276 ounces from the Kirkland Lake field and 66,133 ounces from other sources.

Quebec production for June, 1942 was 90,723 ounces or 3.6 per cent above the June, 1941 total of 87,591 ounces, and 3.7 per cent below the May, 1942 total of 94,251 ounces.

British Columbia produced 44,935 ounces compared with 40,418 ounces for May, 1942 and 55,047 ounces for June, 1941.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 29,456 ounces in June, an increase of 8.8 per cent over the June, 1941 total of 27.078 ounces.

Production for the Yukon amounted to 10,152 ounces in June as against an output of 9,733 ounces for June, 2941.

In the Northwest Territories production amounted to 10,219 ounces for June, 1942 and 4,785 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 1,597 ounces and for June, 1941 the shipments totalled 1,622 ounces.
