GOLD PRODUCTIOIT IN CANADA - FMBRUAPV, 1943
DOMINLON BERLEIO
Gold production in Canada during February, 1943 was recorded 04327.404 fine ounces; for January, 1943 the production was 334,510 fine ounces and for Pebruary, 1942 was 375,630 fine ounces, according to a report just issued by the Dominion pureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

In Ontario the gold production for Pebruary, 1943 totalled 187,293 ounces, made up of 89,032 ounces from the P supine Camp, 57,550 ounces from the Firkzand Lake and Larder Lake areas and 40 : 711 ounces from other sources. For February, 1942 the output was 213,674 ounces, made up of 109,433 ounces from the Porcupine Camp, 48,154 ounces from the Kirkland Lake and Larder Lake areas and $5 ६, 087$ ounces from other sources.

Quebec production during February, 1943 was 84,280 ounces as against 76,594 ounces for Jenuary, 1943 and 90,502 ounces for Fobruary: 1942.

British Columbia produced 25,218 ounces in February compared with 23,802 ounces for January, 1943 and 42,809 ounces for February, 1942.

Manitoba and Saskatchewan produced 23,477 ounces in February, 1943 compared with 22,138 ounces for Fabmary, 1942.

Production for the Tukon amounted to $\epsilon 2$ ounces for Pebruary as against an output of 150 ounces for February, 1942.

In the Northwest Territories production amounted to 5,945 ounces for February, 1943 and 5,874 ounces for the same month a year ago.

Nova Scotia shipments to the Royal Canadian Mint amounted to 589 ounces and for February, 1942 the shipments totalled 483 ources.
