Gold production in Canada during April, 1943 totalled 323,073 fine ounces as compared with 420,795 fine ounces in April a year ago, and 347,685 ounces in March of the present year. The value of the April production was 12,438,310.


Of the total production, 269,936 fine ounces came from auriferous quartz mines and alluvial sources, and 53,137 fine ounces came from base metal mines.

Gold production from auriferous quartz mines (including placer gold) dropped 22.6 per cent during the first four months of the present year as compared with the same period a year ago. Production of gold from base metal mines increased 9 per cent when the same periods are compared.

Employees in auriferous quartz mines, including both salaried employees and wage-earners, numbered 20,066 in March as compared with 27,527 in March, 1942.
