

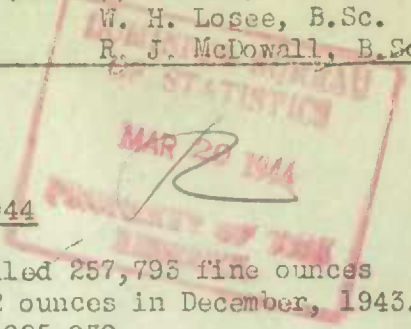

MONTHLY REPORT



GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JANUARY, 1944

Gold production in Canada during January, 1944 totalled 257,793 fine ounces compared with 334,510 fine ounces in January, 1943 and 262,882 ounces in December, 1943. The value of the January, 1944 gold production amounted to \$9,925,030.

Of the total gold production for January, 1944, 211,659 fine ounces came from auriferous quartz mines and alluvial sources, and 46,134 fine ounces originated in base metal mines.

Gold produced by auriferous quartz mines and placers dropped 26.8 per cent in January, 1944 as compared with the production from the corresponding sources in January, 1943.

Employees in auriferous quartz mines, including both salaried employees and wage-earners, numbered 16,207 in January as compared with 21,123 in January, 1943, and 16,033 in December, 1943.
