MONTHLY REPORT

GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JANUARY, 1945

Gold production in Canada during January, 1945 totalled 233,210 fine ounces compared with 257,793 fine ounces in January, 1944 and 228,901 ounces in December, 1944. The value of the January, 1945 gold production was \$8,974,350.

Of the total gold production for January, 1945, 194,703 fine ounces came from auriferous quartz mines and alluvial deposits, and 38,507 fine ounces originated in base metal mines.

Gold produced in auriferous quartz mines and placers decreased 8.0 per cent in January. 1945 as compared with the production from the corresponding sources in January, 1944. Production of gold from base metal mines decreased 16.5 per cent in a comparison of the same periods.

Employees in producing auriferous quartz mines, including both salaried employees and wage-earners, numbered 15,464 in January, 1945; the corresponding total for active non-producing mines was 771. In January, 1945 employees in nonferrous metal mines, smelters, and refineries totalled 35,219.
