## Monthly Report

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1946

Gold production during November, 1946, totalled 231,204 fine ounces compared with 240,828 fine ounces in the previous month and 224,542 fine ounces in November, 1945. The value of the production in the current month was \$8,092,140.

Production in November included 202,916 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 28,288 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous quartz mines and placers rose 5.6 per cent over November of last year, and production from base metal mines declined 12.6 per cent.

Employees in producing auriferous quartz mines, including salaried employees and wage-carners, numbered 16,991 in November, 1946; the corresponding total for active non-producing mines was 773. Employees in non-ferrous metal mines, smelters and refineries totalled 27,601 during the month under review.
