## GOLD PRODOCTION IN CANANA, AUGUST, 1946

Gold production during August, 1946, totalled 231,200 5ine ounces aompared whth 239,55k fine ounces in the previous month and 211,754 fine ounces in August, 1945. The velue of the production in the current month was $18,901,200$.

Production.in August included 197,643 fine ounces from auriferous quartz aines and 33,557 fine ounoes from base metal mines. Output from auriferous quartz mines and placers robe 11.9 per aent over August of last year, and production from base metal wines rose 4.4 per cent.

Employess in producing auriferous quart 2 mines, including both salaried employeea and wageearners, nubered 17,053 in August, 1946 ; thy corrssponding total for active non-producing mines was 625. Tmpiusees in non-ferrous metel wines, smelters and refineries tntalled 27,023 during the month under review.
