## Monthly Report

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1947

Gold production during February, 1947, totalled 222,142 fine ounces compared with 233,825 fine ounces in the previous month and with 228,939 fine ounces in February, 1946. The value of the gold production in February was \$7,774,970.

Production in February included 207,431 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 14,711 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous quartz mines and placers rese 8.6 per cent over rebruary of 1946, and production from base metal mines decreased 61.7 per cent.

Employees in producing auriferous quartz mines, including salaried employees and wageearners, numbered 18,741 in February, 1947; the corresponding total for active non-producing mines was 312. Employees in non-ferrous metal mines, smelters and refineries totalled 29,987 during the month under review.
