## Monthly Report

## GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA, APRIL, 1947

Gold production during April, 1947, totalled 255,177 fine ounces compared with 263,209 fine ounces in the previous month and with 238,216 fine ounces in April, 1946. The value of the gold production in April was \$8,927,695.

Production in April included 229,770 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 25,407 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous quartz mines and placers rose 16.6 per cent over April, 1946, and production from base metal mines decreased 38.2 per cent.

Employees in producing auriferous quartz mines, including salaried employees and wage-earners, numbered 18,665 in April, 1947; the corresponding total for active non-producing mines was 488. Employees in non-ferrous metal mines, smelters and refineries totalled 31,747 during the month under review.
