## Monthly Report

## GOLD PRODUGTION IN CANADA, JANUARY, 1948

Gold production during January, 1948, totalled 274,104 fine ounces compared with 274,636 fine ounces in the previous month and 234,137 fine ounces in January, 1947. The value of gold production in January, 1948 was \$9,593,640.

Produotion in Junuery included 241,873 fine ounces from auriforous quartz mines and 32,231 fine ounces from base metal mincs. Output irom auriferous quartz mines and placers increased 11.5 per cent over January, 1947 and production from base metal mines increased 86.2 per cent.
