GOLD PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1949

Gold production during February, 1949 totalled 307,472 fine ounces compared with 308,989 fine ounces in the previous month and with 261,603 fine ounces in February, 1948. The value of gold production in February, 1949 was \$10,761,520.

Production in February included 278,165 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 29,307 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous quartz mines and placers increased 20.6 per cent and production from base metal mines decreased 5.5 per cent over February, 1948.
