Gold production during February, 1950 totalled 350,704 fine ounces compared with 353,911 fine ounces in the previous month and with 307,608 fine ounces in February, 1949. The value of gold production In February, 1950 was $\$ 13,502,104$.

Production in February included 305,030 fine ounces fram auriferous quartz nines and 45,674 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers increased 9.6 per cent, and production from base metal mines rose 55.8 per cent over Pebruary, 1949.
