GOLD PRODUCTION

JANUARY - 1951

Gold production during January, 1951 totalled 374,483 fine ounces compared with 383,067 fine ounces in December, 1950 and with 354,254 fine ounces in January, 1950. The value of gold production in January, 1951, was \$13,784,719.

Production in January included 322,281 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 52,202 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers increased 5.1 per cent, and production from base metal mines increased 9.3 per cent over January, 1950.
