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## D.B.S. MEMORANDUM

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GOLD PRODUCTION February - 1951 Price \$1.00 per year

Gold production during February, 1951 totalled 347,053 fine ounces compared with 374,483 fine ounces in the previous month and with 349,904 fine ounces in February, 1950. The value of gold production in February, 1951 was \$12,747,257.

Production in February included 303,126 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 43,927 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers decreased 0.4 per cent, and production from base metal mines decreased 3.8 per cent over February, 1950.
