GOLD PRODUCTION



## FEBRUARY - 1952

Gold oroduction during February, 1952 totalled 352,667 fine ounces, compared with 354,561 fine ounces in the orevious month and with 347,091 fine ounces in February, 1951. The value of gold production in February, 1952 was $\$ 12,353,925$, calculated at average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in February included 307,504 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 45,163 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers increased 1.4 per cent, and production from base metal mines increased 2.8 per cent from February, 1951.
