# DOMINION BUREAU OF STATISTICS 

GOLD PRODUGTION

Cold production during January, 1954, totalled 293,049 fine ounces compared with 274,616 fine ounces in the previous month and with 371,265 fine ounces in January, 1953. The value of gald production in January, 1954, was $\$ 9,978,318$ calculated at the average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in January included 274,357 fino ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 28,692 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers decreased 25.2 per cent, and production from base metal mines decreased 60.7 per cent from January, 1953.
