## GOLD PRODUCTION

Gold production during Fobriary, 1954, totalied 310,657 fine ounces compared with 293,049 fine ounces in the previous month and with $352,895 \mathrm{Pin}$ ounces in February, 1953. The value of gold production in February, 1954 , was $\$ 20,509,526$ calculated at the average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in February included 288,324 fine ounces from auriferous quartz wines and 22,333 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers decreased 7.2 per cent, and production from bese metal mines decreased 47.3 per cent from February, 1953.
