## GOLD PRODUCTION

Gold production during March, 1955, totalled 372,038 fine cunces compared with 351,583 fine cunces in the previous month and with 369,432 fine cunces in March, 1954. The value of gold production in March, 1955, was \$12,816,709 calculated at the average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in March included 332,511 fine cunces from auriferous quartz mines and 39,527 fine cunces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous mines and placers increased 1.2 per cent, and production from base metal mines decreased 3.0 per cent from March, 1954.
