## GOLD PRODUCTION

Gold production during March, 1958, totalled 390,828 fine ounces compared with 358,435 fine ounces In the previous month and with 375,702 fine ounces in March, 1957. The value of gold production in March, 1958, wat $\$ 13,368,272$ calculated at the average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in March included 339,254 fine ounces from auriferous quartz mines and 51,574 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from wriferous mines and placers increased 5.8 per cent, and production from base metal mines decreased 6.4 per cent- Frow March, 1957.
