## COLD PRODUCTION

Gold Production durine April 1963, totalled 337,679 fine ounces compared whithesil,669 Yine ounces in the previous month and with 356,480 fine ounces in April 1962. The value of gold produc= tion in April 1963, was $\$ 12,727,122$ calculated at the average price paid by the Royal Canadian Mint.

Production in April included 288,484 fine ounces from suriferous quartz mines and 49,195 fine ounces from base metal mines. Output from auriferous nines and placers decreased 6.1 per cent and production from base metal wines increased . 03 per cent from April 1962.
