NATURAL GAS - The production of natural gas in Canada during April amounted to 2,353,619 thousand cubic feet as compared with 2,454,063 thousand cubic feet produced during the corresponding month of 1931.

In April the gas-oil ratio in the Turner Valley was 167,000 cubic feet per barrel of naphtha produced; in March the ratio was 156,000 cubic feet and in April last year, 123,000 cubic feet.

Mixed gas (natural and artificial) imported into Canada totalled 14,967 thousand cubic feet as against the March importations of 13,337 thousand cubic feet.
