GASOLINE - Sales of gasoline in Canada during October totalled 50,906,000 gallons; in September, 60,269,000 gallons were sold and in October, 1932, the total was 45,980,000 gallons. From January to October 31st, 1933, gasoline sales in Canada aggregated 429,432,000 gallons or 1.5 per cent below the quantity sold in the corresponding period of 1932.

Natural casinghead gasoline receipts in October advanced to 5,712,784 gallons worth \$451,538 from the September total of 2,956,529 gallons at \$184,343. Importations of gasoline lighter than .8235 specific gravity at 60° temperature rose to 1,027,204 gallons appraised at \$150,031; the September imports amounted to 757,863 gallons at \$91,529.
