



Mixed gas (natural and artificial) imported into Canada in December reached a total of 10,132 thousand cubic feet appraised at \$6,574 as compared with 9,242 thousand cubic feet worth \$6,807 imported in November.

GASOLINE - The November sales of gasoline in Canada were recorded at 43,856,000 gallons as compared with 50,906,000 gallons in October and 38,237,000 gallons in November, 1932. During the eleven months ending November, 473,288,000 gallons were sold in Canada; in the corresponding period of 1932 sales totalled 474,107,000 gallons.

Receipts of natural casinghead gasoline in Canada during November amounted to 3,620,125 gallons worth \$270,237 as against 5,712,784 gallons at \$451,538 in October. Gasoline, lighter than .8235 specific gravity, imported in November declined to 760,305 gallons valued at \$85,231 from the October total of 1,027,204 gallons with a valuation of \$120,031.
