NATURAL GAS - Natural gas production in Canada during May totalled 1,689,071 M cubic feet, a decline of 24.0 per cent from the April total of 2,222,556 M cubic feet and 4.0 per cent from the May, 1932, output of 1,760,161 M cubic feet.

Canada imported 7,947 thousand cubic feet of mixed gas (natural and artificial) worth \$6,165 during May as compared with 6,842 thousand cubic feet at \$5,189 imported in the preceding month.
