NATURAL GAS - The production of natural gas in Canada during June amounted to 1,131,376 thousand cubic feet; in the preceding month 1,689,071 thousand cubic feet were produced and in June, 1932, the output was 1,130,787 thousand cubic feet.

Mixed gas (natural and artificial) imported into Canada in June totalled 8,084 thousand cubic feet appraised at \$6,121 as compared with 7,947 thousand cubic feet worth \$6,165 imported in May.
