MONTHLY REPORT

PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS PRODUCTION IN CANADA, MARCH, 1946.

Crude Petroleum - The Canadian output of crude petroleum and natural gasoline in March, 1946 amounted to 663,537 parrels.

Alberta's output in March was recorded at 644,205 barrels, including 580,988 barrels from the Turner Valley field, 944 barrels from the Wainwright-Ribstone field, and 62,273 barrels from other fields.

In March, 1946 New Brunswick produced 2,220 barrels; Ontario, 8,939 barrels; Saskatchewan, 4,603 barrels, and the Northwest Territories 3,570 barrels.



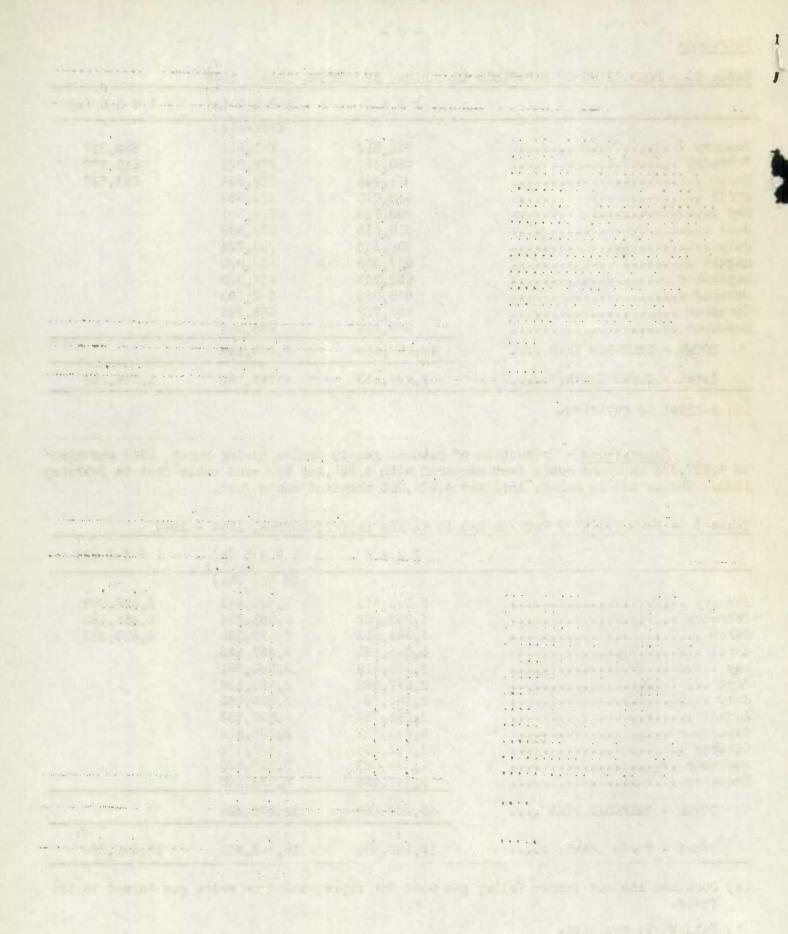
