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MONTHLY REPORT

PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS PRODUCTION IN CANADA, MAY, 1946.

Crude Petroleum - The Canadian output of crude petroleum and natural gasoline in May, 1946 amounted to 649,888 barrels.

Alberta's output in May was recorded at 598,018 barrels, including 534,249 barrels from the Turner Valley field, 1,178 barrels from the Wainwright-Ribstone field, and 62,591 barrels from other fields.

In May, 1946 New Brunswick produced 2,804 barrels; Ontario, 10,894 barrels; Saskatchewan, 11,366 barrels, and the Northwest Territories 26,806 barrels.
