ZINC - Zinc output in Canada during June amounted to 15,619,628 pounds and in July to 14,345,809 pounds. The total Canadian output during the first seven months of 1933 was 97,656,183 pounds as compared with 104,272,065 pounds in the corresponding period of 1932.

Zinc quotations on the London market advanced to an average of 3.4999 cents per pound (in Canadian funds) in June; valued at this price the Canadian output was worth \$546,671. In July, quotations continued the advance recorded since January and rose to 3.9171 cents per pound in Canadian funds at which price the month's output was worth \$561,940. On the St. Louis market prices ranged from 4.3 cents per pound on June 1st to 5 cents per pound towards the end of July. The June average was 4.348 cents per pound and the July, 4.878 cents per pound.

The American Bureau of Metal Statistics records the world output of zinc in June at 85,575 tons. In July, production advanced to 95,188 tons, the highest recorded monthly output since May, 1931. A 28.6 per cent increase in the United States zinc production was mainly responsible for the July advance in output. The United States shipments of zinc totalled 45,689 tons, or 24.4 per cent above the tonnage shipped in June. Stocks on hand in the United States on July 31st amounted to 109,140 tons as compared with 123,924 tons on June 30th.
