Historical File Copy SILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION IN CANADA. JUNE, 1934.

SILVEN - Dilver production in Canada during June amounted to 1,161,702 cunces; in the preceding month, 1,508,323 cunces were produced and in June, 1933, the output was 885,427 ounces.

The month opened with silver quoted at 44.625 cents per ounce on the New York market; on the second the low mark for June of 44.5 cents per ounce was quoted and on the twenty-ninth and thirtieth the high for the month of 46.25 cents per ounce was reached. In Canadian funds, the June average price was 44.82065 cents per ounce, at which price the Canadian output was worth \$520,682. The May average price was 44.1464 cents per ounce and the computed value of the month's production, \$665,870.


The world output of silver in June was estimated at 14,866,000 ounces as compared with 16,131,000 ounces in May. Mexico produced 6,461,000 ounces in June; in the preceding month 7,065,000 ounces were produced. The United States production advanced to 2,312,000 ounces from the May total of 2,303,000 ounces. Silver stocks held by United States refineries at the end of June amounted to 7,907,000 ounces, an increase of 733,000 ounces during the month. Shanghai silver stocks on June 30th totalled 446,220,000 ounces, a decline of 1,120,000 ounces from the total on hand on June 2nd. Indian currency reserve. in silver coin and bullion, at the ena of June was equivalent to 333,988,000 ounces as against 331,066,000 ounces on May 31st.

LEAD - Canada produced 28,613,779 pounds of load during June as compared with 25,939,731 pounds in May and 20,778,657 pounds in June, 1933.

The average price of lead on the London market, in Canadian funds, was 2.4734 cents per pound; valued at this price the Canadian output in June was worth \$707,733. The May average price was 2.516175 conts per pound and the estimated value of the month's production was \$652,689. Quotations for lead on the New York market remained steady at 4 cents per pound from the first to the twenty-seventh; on the following day a decline to 3.85 cents per pound was recorded and on the twenty-ninth and thirtieth 3.75 cents per pound was the prevailing quotation. As usual the St. Louis market quotations followed a similar trend, ranging from a high of 3.85 cents per pound to a closing low bid of 3.6 cents per pound.



During June the refined lead output of the world totalled 122,172 tons. a decline of 10,080 tons from the May production. The United States produced 29,695 tons, a 14.5 per cent falling-off from the May total of 34,741 tons. A 4.7 per cent increase was recorded in Australia's production; the June total was 18,492 tons and Mexico's output declined 24.4 per cent to 13,246 tons. the May, 17,655 tons.

Refined lead stocks in the United States increased 4,936 tons during June to a total of 238,181 tons. Stocks of lead in British official warehouses at the end of June included 15,715 tons duty-free and 14,559 tons in bond.



ZINC - Canada's zinc production in June amounted to 21,617,223 pounds as compared with 26,132,534 pounds in May and 15,884,010 pounds in June, 1933.

Quotations for zinc on the London market, in Canadian funds, declined to 3.1865 cents per pound from the May average of 3.352 cents per pound. Valued at these prices the Canadian output in June was worth \$688,833 and in May, \$875,963. On the St. Louis market quotations fluctuated slightly during June; the average for the month was 4.24 cents per pound as against 4.346 cents per pound in May.

Customs' records show that Canada exported 4,167,100 pounds of zinc in ore during June; in May 2,378,100 pounds were exported. Zinc spelter exportations declined to 18,157,300 pounds from the May total of 22,020,700 pounds.

Zinc production of the world declined 8,6 per cent in June to 98,831 tons from the May output of 108,179 tons. All the principal zinc producing countries reported decreased outputs during June. Stocks held by the International Zinc Cartel on June 30th totalled 122,378 tons, a decline of 4,477 tons during the The United States stocks of zinc decreased 5,043 tons in June to 99,689 month. tons.
