ILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION IN CANADA, AUGUST, 1934.

SILVER - Canadian producers reported an output of 1,725,673 ounces of silver in August; in the preceding month 1,237,340 ounces were produced and in August, 1933, the total was 1,458,234 ounces. According to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa the August output was the highest monthly total on record since July, 1932. During the eight months ending August Canada produced 10,674,681 ounces of silver or 5.1 per cent above the production in the corresponding period of 1933.


The average price of silver on the New York market has shown a steady advance since May, 1934, when 44.226 cents per ounce was quoted; the average for August was 48.986 cents per ounce. In Canadian funds the August average price was 47.8532 cents per ounce, at which price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$825,790. The July quotations averaged 45.76586 cents per ounce and the computed value of the month's output was \$566,279.

Exports of silver bullion from Canada in August consisted of 599,503 ounces to Great Britain, 263,650 ounces to the United States and 164,820 ounces to British India.

The world output of silver in August totalled 15,436,000 cunces as compared with 13,667,000 cunces in July. An advance of 22.8 per cent in the Mexican production to 6,536,000 cunces was mainly responsible for the increased world output. Stocks of silver on hand at United States refineries declined 2,797,000 cunces in August to a total of 5,068,000 cunces. According to the American Bureau of Metal Statistics Canadian refinery stocks on August 31st amounted to 2,257,000 cunces. On September 1st Shanghai silver stocks were equivalent to 379,460,000 cunces as against 427,200,000 cunces on hand on August 4th. Indian currency reserve in silver coin and bullion on August 31st was equivalent to 340,828,000 cunces, a decline of 825,000 cunces during the month.

Silver was nationalized in the United States by executive order on August 9th. This order compelled the turning in at the United States mints within 90 days of all silver except silver coin, fabricated silver, metal under license or owned by foreign governments and central banks and small supplies not held for value as bullion. The mints will deduct seigniorage and charges for silver received under the order amounting to 61.32 per cent of the statutory price (\$1.2929 per ounce), and will return to the depositor in standard silver dollars or other currency an amount equal to the monetary value of the balance, or 50.010505 cents per fine ounce. Newly mined United States silver will be bought as heretofore at 64g cents per ounce. Regulations effecting the nationalization of silver were issued by the United States Treasury on August 17th and followed along the general lines of the Executive Order of August 9th.

IEAD - Canada produced 30,276,573 pounds of lead in August; during the preceding month 30,140,043 pounds were produced and in August, 1933, the total was 24,349,685 pounds. The output during the eight months ending August totalled 219,412,065 pounds or 23.2 per cent above the production in the corresponding months of 1933.

Lead quotations on the London market, in Canadian funds, have shown a steady decline since April. The average price in August was 2.39168 cents per pound and the computed value of the month's output, \$724,119. The July quotations averaged 2.406423 cents per pound at which price the Canadian output was worth \$725,297. On the New York market lead averaged 3.74? cents per pound and on the St. Louis market the average was 5.597 cents per pound.

Lead in ore exported from Canada in August amounted to 5,955,800 pounds as against 494,700 pounds in the previous month. Exports of pig lead declined to 24,112,400 pounds from the July total of 25,458,500 pounds.


The world production of refined lead in August was recorded at 114,158 tons or 7.3 per cent below the July cutput of 123,176 tons. A 15.9 per cent decline was shown in the United States production; the August total was 22,999 tons as against 2',354 tons in the preceding month. Mexico's output amounted to 12,990 tons as compared with 21,875 tons in July. Australia's production advanced 21.7 per cent in August to 18,755 tons.

Refined lead stocks on hand in the United States declined 6,283 tons during august to a total of 254,312 tons at the end of the month. Stocks of lead in British official Metal Exchange warehouses on August 51st consisted of 8,623 tons of duty free and 15,647 tons in bond. Duty free stocks showed a decrease of 4,222 tons during the month.

ZINC - Zinc production in Canada set up a new high monthly output record in August when 30,028,555 pounds were produced. The July output was 22,186,356 pounds and the total for August a year ago was 16,575,867 pounds. A 63.7 per cent increase was recorded in the Canadian output of zinc in the first eight months of 1934 as compared with the total for the corresponding months of 1933.

Zinc quotations on the London market, in Canadian funds, averaged 3.024 cents per pound in August; valued at this price the Canadian output was worth \$908,064. The July average price was 2.99685 cents per pound and the value of the month's production, \$664,892. On the St. Louis market zinc averaged 4.281 cents per pound as against 4.317 cents per pound in the preceding month.

Exports of zinc in ore from Canada in August amounted to 4,255,400 pounds; none was exported in July. An advance of 5.4 per cent was recorded in the exports of zinc spelter in August when 20,108,500 pounds were shipped from Canada as against 19,071,000 pounds in the previous month.

A 4.4 per cent advance was shown in the world output of zinc in August; the month's total was 104,095 tons as compared with 99,698 tons in July. The International Zinc Cartel stocks of zinc increased 3,681 tons in August to a total of 120,876 tons. In the United States stocks were 4,610 tons higher on August 31st and amounted to 102,192 tons.
