MONTHLY REPORT

ILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION IN CANADA - SEPTEMBER, 1936.

SILVER - The Canadian production of silver in September declined to 1,328,661 ounces from the August total of 1,539,360 ounces and the September, 1935, output of 1,347,904 ounces, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the nine months ending September, 13,110,327 ounces were produced; this represented an advance of 9.6 per cent over the output in the corresponding months of 1935.

Silver quotations on the New York market (Handy and Harman) in September averaged 44.7366 cents per ounce, in Canadian funds; in August the average price was 44.7545 cents per ounce. Based on these monthly prices, the Canadian output in September was worth \$594,398 and in August, \$688,933.

Exports of silver bullion from Canada in September recorded a 73.3 per cent falling off to 416,994 ounces from the previous month's total of 1,559,496 ounces. The United States received 81.7 per cent of the September exports and Great Britain, the remainder. Exportations of silver in ore, concentrates, etc., in September advanced to 733,199 ounces from the August exports of 431,329 ounces.


Imports of silver bullion into Canada in September totalled 92,734 ounces as compared with 201,842 ounces imported in August. The September importations were obtained from the United States.

The American Bureau of Metal Statistics estimated the world output of silver at 21,788,000 ounces as compared with 1,508,000 ounces in August. Mexico produced 7,078,000 ounces of silver in September; in the preceding month 7,854,000 ounces were produced. Silver production in the United States rose 16.7 per cent to 5,524,000 ounces in September. Peru's output was slightly higher at 1,525,000 ounces. Australia produced 672,000 ounces of refined silver as against 657,000 ounces in August.

Silver stocks in the licensed vaults of the Canadian Commodity Exchange at Montreal were as follows:-

LEAD - Lead production in Canada during September declined to 29,128,356 pounds from the August output of 33,987,026 pounds. In September, a year ago, 26,471,867 pounds were produced. The Canadian output during the first nine months of 1936 totalled 276,231,332 pounds as compared with 243,837,291 pounds in the corresponding months of 1935.

Lead quotations on the London market have recorded a steady advance during the past three months and in September averaged 4.05122 cents per pound, in Canadian funds. Valued at this price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$1,180,054. The August average price was 3.76359 cents per pound and the value of the month's production was \$1,279,132.

Pig lead exports from Canada in September amounted to 28,655,800 pounds; in the preceding month 30,293,000 pounds were exported. Exports of lead in ore, concentrates, etc., in September were lower at 984,800 pounds.

The United States production of refined lead in September was recorded at 29,788 tons as compared with 31,117 tons in August. Stocks of lead in the United States declined 17,716 tons in September to 200,517 tons. Mexico produced 18,675 tons of lead during the month; in August, 20,004 tons were produced. Australia's output was 5.3 per cent lower at 16,787 tons, on the other hand, Germany's production rose 15.5 per cent to 13,977 tons.



ZINC - The Canadian production of zinc in September was recorded at 31,133,738 pounds as compared with 33,506,293 pounds in August and 27,125,462 pounds in September, 1935. During the nine months ending September, Canada produced 257,067,130 pounds of zinc; a year ago, 235,760,936 pounds were produced.

The average price of zinc on the London market in September was 3.12823 cents per pound in Canadian funds; valued at this price the Canadian output during the month was \$973,935. In August, zinc averaged 3.03565 cents per pound and the month's output was worth \$837,751.

Customs' records show that 27,428,100 pounds of zinc spelter were exported from Canadalin September as against 32,988,000 pounds in the preceding month. Exports of zinc in ore, concentrates, etc., during September declined to 2,481,800 pounds from the August total of 16,830,200 pounds.

The world production of zinc in September was estimated at 134,083 tons. or an average of 4,469 tons per day; in August, 137,714 tons, were produced, or a daily average of 4,482 tons. Production in the United States amounted to 42,283 tons as compared with 43,614 tons in August. Germany and Australia produced approximately the same tonnages as in the preceding month; the totals for September were 12,346 tons and 12,453 tons, respectively.
