MONTHLY REPORT ST.F SILVER, LEAD AND SINC PRODUCTION IN CAMADA - JANUARY, 1937.

SILVER - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian output of silver in January amounted to 1,390,476 ounces. In December, 1,835,604 ounces were produced while in January, 1936, the production was 1,213,488 ounces.

Silver quotations on the New York market (Handy and Herman) averaged 44.9262 cents per ounce in January, in Canadian funds; based on this price, the Canadian output during the month was worth \$624,688. The Lecember average price was 45.32025 cents per ounce and the value of the month's production was \$831,900.

Silver bullion exports during January advanced to 934,510 ounces from the preceding month's total of 683,142 ounces. Exportations of silver in ore, concentrates, etc., were recorded at 119,310 ounces as compared with 186,329 ounces exported in December.


Imports of silver bullion into Caneda in January declined to 127,932 ounces worth 056,026 from the December importations of 449,860 ounces valued at \$197,872. The United States supplied 93.3 per cent of the January imports and Great Britain, the remainder.

The estimated world production of silver in January was 23,165,000 ounces as compared with 19,594,000 ounces produced in December. Mexico produced 8,765,000 ounces in January; during the preceding month 3,748,000 ounces were produced. The United States output declined to 5,409,000 ounces from the December total of 6,135,000 ounces. The Peruvian production in January amounted to 1,600,000 ounces as egainst 1,684,000 in the previous month.

LEAD - Lead production in Canada during January amounted to 34,112,307 pounds; in December, 40,389,544 pounds were produced. while in January, 1936, the output was 28,105,650 pounds.

The average price of lead on the London market, in Canadian funds, in January was 5.97738 cents per pound, at which price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$2,039,022. In December, lead averaged 5.59604 cents per pound and the value of the month's production was \$2,260,215.


Exports of pig lead from Canada in January rose to 34,194,300 pounds from the December total of 22,459,100 pounds. Lead in ore, concentrates, etc., exported from Canada in January amounted to 504,500 pounds as against 377,300 pounds exported in December.

Refined lead production in the United States was recorded at 41,223 tons in January; during the preceding month 43,613 tons were produced. Stocks in the United States at the end of January totalled 169,776 tons; this represented a decline of 2,080 tons during the month. Mexico's output rose 4.9 per cent in January to 21,449 tons from the previous month's total of 20,442 tons. Australia's output in January was slightly higher at 19,637 tons. The German production was 6.3 per cent lower at 14,652 tons.

ZINC - The output of zinc by Canadian producers in January totalled 19,782,526 pounds as against 21,294,862 pounds in December and 27,384,732 pounds in January, 1936.

Sinc everaged 4.83659 cents per pound on the London market, in Canadian funds, in January; valued at this price, the Canadian output during the month was worth \$917,175. The December average price was 3.93146 cents per pound and the value of the month's production was \$837,199.

Canada exported zinc spelter to a total of 19,280,300 pounds in January as compared with 18,336,900 pounds exported in the preceding month. There were no exports of zinc in ore, concentrates, etc., from Canada in January.

The American Bureau of Metal Statistics estimates the world production of zinc in January at 137,815 tons or 4.9 per cent below the tonnage produced in December. Output in the United States in January amounted to 40,025 tons; in the previous month 47,050 tons were produced. On January 31st stocks of zinc in the United States totalled 34,143 tons or a decline of 10,613 tons during the month.
