MONTHLY REPORT

SILVER, LEAD and ZINC PRODUCTION IN CANADA - AUGUST, 1938

SILVER - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian output of silver in August amounted to 2,139,043 ounces in July, 2,584,296 ounces were produced while in August, 1937, production totallod 3,059,196 ounces. During the first eight months of the current year, 15,422,832 ounces of silver were produced compared with 15,553,009 ounces a year ago.

Silver quotations on the New York market (Handy & Harman) averaged 42.893 cents per ounce in Canadian funds; based on this price the August output in Canada was worth \$917,500. In July the average price was 42.972 cents per ounce and the value of the month's production was \$1,110,524.

Exports of silver bullion in August rose to 2,133,264 ounces from the July total of 615,772 ounces and the August, 1957, exportations of 1,200,726 ounces. Silver in ore, concentrates, etc., exported from Canada in August amounted to 1,110,876 ounces; in the preceding month, 973,300 ounces were exported.

Imports of silver bullion into Canada in August consisted of 77,684 ounces valued at \$31,517 and included 64,684 ounces from the United States and 13,000 ounces from Great Britain. In July, 122,100 ounces worth (50,362 were imported.

The United States produced 5,596,000 ounces of silver in August compared with 4,530,000 ounces produced in the previous month. The Peruvian output declined to 1,775,000 ounces from the July total of 1,900,000 ounces. The world production of silver, exclusive of Mexico, advanced to 18,491,000 ounces or 9.2 per cent above the preceding month's output.

LEAD - Lead producers in Canada reported an output of 59,826,892 pounds in August; during July, 38,724,783 pounds were produced while in August, 1937, the output totalled 40,566,787 pounds. An increase of 4.9 per cent was recorded in the Canadian output of lead during the first eight months of 1938 compared with the production a year ago; the totals were 283,787,318 pounds and 270,563,827 pounds, respectively.

The average price of lead on the London market in August was 3.131 cents per pound in Canadian funds: valued at this price the Canadian output during the month was worth \$1,246,980. In July, lead averaged 3.29 cents per pound and the value of the month's production was \$1,274,045.


Pig lead exports from Canada in August rose 75.2 per cent to 34,017,800 pounds from the preceding month's total of 19,415,500 pounds. Exportations of lead in ore, concentrates, etc., amounted to 1,617,000 pounds; in July, 1,101,800 pounds were exported.

The American Bureau of Metal Statistics estimated the world output of lead in August at 147,409 tons or 3.8 per cent below the preceding month's total. Production in the United States declined 15.2 per cent to 25,723 tons. This reduction was due, in part, to a strike at the East Helena smelter of the American Smelting & Refining Company. Stocks held in the United States on August 31st totalled 142,868 tons; this represented a decrease of 11,363 tons during the month. Mexico produced 23,340 tons in August compared with 24,437 tons in July. The Australian output, including Australian lead refined in Great Britain, amounted to 21,144 tons; in the preceding month, 21,276 tons were produced.

ZINC - The Canadian output of zinc in August was recorded at 29,591,363 pounds; in the preceding month, 28,367,785 pounds were produced while in August, a year ago, the output was 37,867,371 pounds. During the first eight months of 1938 Canada produced 255,802,245 pounds of zinc or 5.2 per cent above the quantity produced in the corresponding period of 1937.

(x) Unwrought lead in pigs, ingots, blocks, bars, slabs and cakes.

Quotations for zinc on the London market averaged 2.933 cents per pound in Canadian funds compared with 3.119 cents per pound in July. Based on these prices the Canadian output in August was worth \$367,915 and in July, \$384,791.

Zinc spelter exports in August declined to 17,664,300 pounds from the preceding month's total of 20,657,000 pounds. No zinc concentrates were exported from Canada during the month; in July the zinc content of concentrates exported amounted to 6,723,600 pounds.

The world output of zinc in August was estimated at 137,097 tons or 4,422 tons per day; in July, 136,430 tons were produced or a daily rate of 4,401 tons. Production in the United States advanced to 32,298 tons from the July total of 30,362 tons. United States shipments during the month were 4,211 tons above the production with the result that stocks declined a corresponding amount to 141,997 tons.
