Silver production in Canada during danuary was recorded at 1,652,681 ounces; in December $1,785,081$ ounces were proiuced while in Jenuary, 1939 the output totalled $1,532,922$ ornces, according to a report just issued bi the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Silver quotations, on the New Yoris market, (Handy \& Harmain) in Jamary averaged 38.225 cents per ounce, in Canadan funss; compared mith 38.452 cents per ounce in the preceding month. Based on these pricea, the Canadian production was worth $\$ 631,737$ in Jamary and \$686,399 in December.

Canada exported 1,355,190 cuisees of silver bullion in Jenuary; during the previous monti, $1,276,704$ ounces were sxprrted. Jnoorts of silver in ore, concentrates, etc. amounted to 237,546 ounces as against 272,668 in Decomber.

Imports of silver bullion jato Canada in Jamary declined to 149.550 ounces from the December total of 163.193 ounces.

The United States produced $4,35,000$ omnces of silver in Jamary $0: 15 \cdot 1$ per cent below the preceding month's total. Feru produced 2.550,000 ounces as against 1,350,000 ounces in December.
