Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 1,060,299 fine ounces in April, 1949 compared with 1,074,676 fine ounces in the previous month and with 1,089,755 fine ounces in April. 1948.

Lead - Production of primary lead in all forms and the recoverable lead content of Canadian ores during April, 1949 amounted to 11,273 tons compared with 9,820 tons in the previous month and with 12,845 tons in April, 1948.

Output of refined lead, including amounts recovered from foreign ores which were treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 10,408 tons in April compared with 12,885 tons in the corresponding month of last year.



Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores), during April, 1949 amounted to 17,184 tons compared with 23,434 tons in the previous month and with 18,544 tons in April, 1948.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 17,217 tons in April compared with 15,545 tons in the corresponding month of last year.


