Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during April, 1952, amounted to 29,342 tons, compared with 28,790 tons in the previous month and with 25,619 tons in April, 1951.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 18,495 tons in April, 1952, compared with 17,434 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
