Zinc - Production of primary zinc in all forms (the recoverable zinc content of Canadian ores) during July, 1953, amounted to 33,946 tons, compared with 33,821 tons in the previous month and with 34,259 tons in July, 1952.

Output of refined zinc, including amounts recovered from foreign ores treated in Canadian smelters, totalled 21,595 tons in July, 1953, compared with 19,411 tons in the corresponding month of last year.
